OFFICIAL ELECTION NOTICE

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE, that in accordance with the Constitution of the Middle Island Teachers' Association, the Nominating and Elections Committee hereby notifies you of our General Election to be held on <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 7, 2024</u>, to elect Officers* and Building Representatives. All terms of office are for two years commencing July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026.

In conformity with previous election practices the Committee will adhere to the major guidelines and standards established in the Landrum-Griffin Act: 1. Local elections must be held by secret ballot. 2. All members in good standing have the right to vote. 3. Notice of election must be mailed to each member in good standing to his/her last known address not less than 15 days prior to the election.

The names of the candidates were received in nomination (with consent). Additional names may be entered into nomination by submitting names via email to office@middleislandteachers.org. If names are to appear on the official ballot form, they must be placed in nomination by 12:00 noon on Friday, April 5, 2024. Also this condition prevails if a candidate desires to withdraw his or her name. In compliance with the provisions of our local Constitution, write-in ballots for the election will be accepted on Election Day. Absentee balloting will not be permitted.
