OFFICAL ELECTION PLAN

Please take notice, in accordance with the constitution of the Middle Island Teachers' Association, the Nominations and Elections Committee hereby notifies you of our General Election to be held on Tuesday, May 7, 2024 to elect Officers/NYSUT/AFT/NEA Delegates and Building Representatives. All terms of office are for two years, commencing July 1, 2024 and ending June 30, 2026.

In conformity with previous election practices the Committee will adhere to the major guidelines and standards established in the Landrum-Griffin Act: 1. Local elections must be held by secret ballot. 2. All members in good standing have the right to vote. 3. Notice of election was mailed to each member in good standing to his/her last known address not less than 15 days prior to the election.

In compliance with the provisions of our local Constitution, write-in ballots for the election will be accepted on Election Day, May 7, 2024. Absentee balloting will not be permitted.
